TV show seeks musical prodigies

Detroit producers are looking for talented musicians under age 10 for a new reality show titled "Finding Julian's Band."

The Harmonie Network Thursday said the show involves forming a kids' band to play and record with Motown musical wunderkind Julian Pavone, a tot who was born in 2004 and is considered to be the world's youngest drummer.

Called the "Tiger Woods of the Music Industry," Pavone has taken the world by surprise with his talents, appearing on numerous national and network television shows including "Good Morning America" and "Inside Edition." He's known in print all over the world as he makes personal appearances in musical venues such as the House of Blues.

He released a CD titled "Go Baby!" before he turned 2.
