MACOMB TOWNSHIP, Mich. (July 13, 2011)--Julian Pavone is just seven, and he's recognized by Guinness World Records as the youngest professional drummer in the world.

The Guinness people say Julian was certified as having turned pro on March 21, 2010 when he was 5 years, 10 months and 3 days old.

Under Guinness rules, a drummer must play on at least one commercial record and be paid for the work.

The drummer also must have given at least 20 concerts of 45 minutes or longer within five years.

Julian's dad, Bernie, who is also a drummer, says he used to play music on his wife's stomach while she was pregnant with Julian.
