Julian Pavone is Guinness World Record's ® Youngest Professional Drummer

There are overachievers and then there is Julian Pavone. The seven-year-old is considered a drumming prodigy and currently holds the honor of Guinness World Record's ® Youngest Professional Drummer, a feat he accomplished at 5 years 10 months and 3 days of age.

He began playing the drums while sitting on his father's lap at the age of three months. At 15 months-old, he was offered a contract to be a member of the Cleveland Cavaliers' drumline (The United Drumline, founded by William Winfield, III) making him the youngest member by 16 years! Then, at 20 months-old, Julian recorded a CD, "Go Baby!" with legendary bassist Ralphie Armstrong. Trapper Jack, from WDOK 102.1 (Cleveland), broke the story and Julian has been shocking audiences ever since. Since then, he has received worldwide media coverage with more than 11,000 newspaper and magazine articles published about him.

He has appeared on over 150 television shows from *The Oprah Winfrey Show* to *Good Morning America* and *Seriously Funny Kids*, hosted by Heidi Klum. He also has a television pilot he is working on titled *Finding Julian's Band*® created by Rocky Seprino. Korea's Seoul Broadcasting Systems even produced a documentary about him.

He has received numerous awards and honors, including *Maury's Most Talented Kid* of 2009. At age 3 he was one of *Oprah's Most Talented Kids*.

If being an accomplished drummer wasn't enough, he is also an entrepreneur. He owns several patents on products he created. At 4 he invented the Abracadabra® Stain Cover up. He currently has a patent pending for Julian's Drum Gloves™. Oh, then you have the snack bar he created, Julian's Go Bar™, a healthy bar that provides two servings of fruit and comes in eight orchard fresh flavors.

Julian loves giving back to his community and works with several charities. He was named Muscular Dystrophy Association's Honorary Goodwill Ambassador for 2009 and also served as The Miracle League of Michigan's Honorary Goodwill Ambassador for 2009-2010. He is Athlete's with Disabilities Network (ADN)'s Honorary Global Ambassador and is currently serving as the Macomb-Oakland Regional Center's Global Ambassador.

It's rather hard to believe he is just a kid. He has accomplished more in seven years than most of us do in a lifetime. It leaves me wondering what he will achieve in the next seven years.
